I was brought very low, and he helped me.

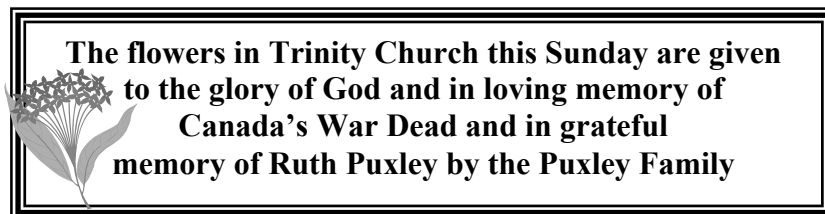
**6 Turn again to your rest, O my soul, \*
