Ps 79:1-9

- 1 O God, the heathen have come into your inheritance;
they have profaned your holy temple; *
they have made Jerusalem a heap of rubble.
- 2 **They have given the bodies of your servants as food for
the birds of the air, *
and the flesh of your faithful ones to the beasts
of the field.**
- 3 They have shed their blood like water on every side
of Jerusalem, *
and there was no one to bury them.
- 4 **We have become a reproach to our neighbours, *
an object of scorn and derision to those around us.**
- 5 How long will you be angry, O Lord? *
will your fury blaze like fire for ever?
- 6 **Pour out your wrath upon the heathen who have not
known you *
and upon the kingdoms that have not called upon
your name.**
- 7 For they have devoured Jacob *
and made his dwelling a ruin.
- 8 **Remember not our past sins;
let your compassion be swift to meet us; *
for we have been brought very low.**
- 9 Help us, O God our Saviour, for the glory of your name; *
deliver us and forgive us our sins, for your name's sake.
