ORGAN PROJECT AT TRINITY ANGLICAN CHURCH, DIGBY, NS

The goal of this project was to make this beautiful heritage building a place where people come together, not only for worship, but for concerts and a wide variety of arts.

An integral part of this worship and arts space is our pipe organ. Our collaboration with the Peninsula Pipe Organ Company of New Brunswick has produced an instrument that incorporates the best of our past—there are pipes in the organ from circa 1880— with additional pipe work which expands and completes this versatile pipe organ. The ‘new to us’ console was built by Casavant Freres of Quebec in 1939: it beautifully blends with the existing woodwork in the church. The completion of this fine instrument has seen a redesign of the organ chamber to facilitate tuning and maintenance as well as a remodeling of the Chancel area (at the front of the church), enhanced lighting and sound.

The organ’s voice will support congregational song, inspire people in worship, and enable the performance of a wide variety of organ literature. It will serve this church and community well for many years to come.
